NOTICE OF RACE

This contest is organized with the help of Antibes Juan les Pins City Hall and Port Gallice.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RSS).
- 1.2 National prescriptions translated for foreign competitors will be joined in appendix "Prescriptions" if necessary.
- 1.3 The FFV regulations, the concerned class rules, this notice of race, the race instructions.
- 1.4 In case of translation of these SI, the French text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.2 Boats may be required to display the advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies. [DP]

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all of the boats from the following series: 505, 420, Finn, Yole Ok, Fireball.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and sending it, together with the required fee to Société des Régates d'Antibes or completing the digital form with the required fee available on our website.
- 3.3 The competitors (each crew member) living in France must present during registration :
 - the valid and signed FFVoile's licence with health certificate and a parents permission for the minors.
 - A valid authorization to display advertising on boat, if necessary.
 The measurement form or certificate of the boat.
- 3.4 Foreign competitors without a French license shall justify their membership to a World Sailing Member national authority
 - shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of 2 000 000 Euros.
 - A health certificate and a parents permission for the minors.
 - A valid authorization to display advertising on boat, if necessary.
 - The measurement form or certificate of the boat.

4. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Laser non Euromaster (Meal is not included)	10 €
Finn, Yole Ok	40 €
420	50 €

The fees includes a crew dinner, the boat parking and the car parking from Wednesday to Sunday. Additional dinner tickets are available for 20 euro each.

5. SCHEDULE

5.1 Registration confirmation at Port Gallice (Juan les Pins) Wednesday January, 16th from 3:00PM to 7:00PM, Thursday January 17th from 10:00AM to 7:00 PM and Friday 18th from 9:00AM to 11:30AM.

5.4 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 3:30 pm

5.5 SKI in Auron :

- A giant slalom (Flèche ESF) will takes place at Auron ski station at 12:00 noon on thursday 17th with complimentary champagne at the bottom of the ski-slopes.
- A voucher to purchase a discounted ski pass can be obtained at registration time at Port Gallice until Wednesday 7:00 pm.
- Last minute registrations for the ski competition can be made in Auron until 11:45 am Thursday before the start of the race.
- All crew and staff can compete but only the best time of the crew will be used for the score of the boat.

5.6 Crew dinner will be on **Saturday** evening at 7:30 pm for 420, Finn, 505, Fireball, Yole Ok classes at the SRA Club House, Port Vauban, Antibes

5.7 Each evening after the race, open bar and hot chocolate.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions and their appendices will be available during the registration confirmation.

7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be as follows: windward/leeward or trapeze.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

8.1 RSS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9. SCORING

9.1 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series

9.2 (a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 4 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones. [DP]

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows : the first 3 of each class overall.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RSS 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13. FURTHER INFORMATION

13.1 Security equipment

All boats must have onboard the totality of the security equipment required by their own class rules and the french rules one's.

13.2 Boat storage

Boats will be parked at Port Gallice, Juan les Pins
